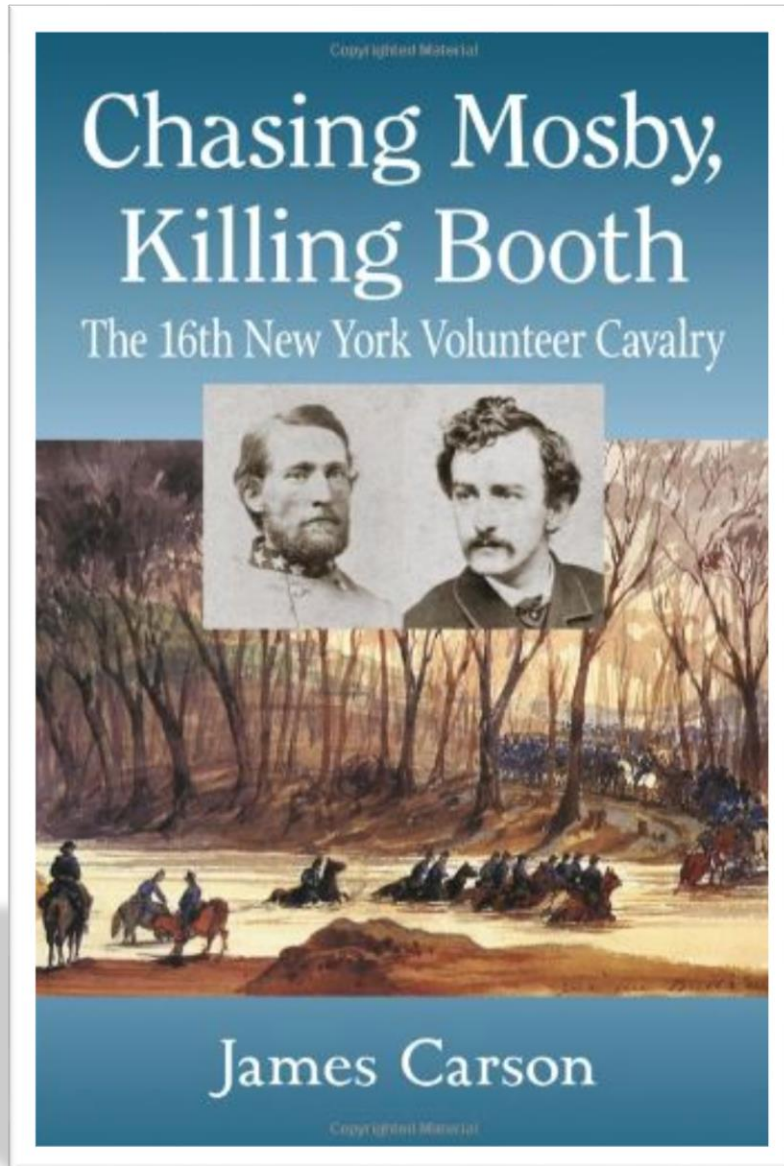


# SARANAC TOWN HALL
